



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the twentieth day of September 1762 granted to the late Henry Bouquet Esqr. I have surveyed on the 25th day of August 1767 the above described Tract of Land situate on the waters of Trough Creek in Trough Creek Valley in the County of Cumberland, containing Two hundred and twenty six acres and a quarter and the usual allowance of six acres p^lt. for Roads &c. called the two Runs. (The Right whereof is now vested in Thomas Willing Esqr.)
