



A Draught of a Tract of Land called "Nutt Grove" situate on Weis caughting or Pine Creek above other Land surveyed for s<sup>d</sup> William Beadly and about four and a quarter Miles from the North East Branch of Susquehanna River in the County of Northumberland Containing Three Hundred and Twenty five acres and a half and the usual Allowances of six Per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1774 for William Beadly in right and as part of one Thousand Acres granted to John Jennings by a special Relocating Order dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of December 1775 in lieu of the Application No 3315 for the same quantity
