



Situate on the Waters of Brush Creek (formerly in
Londonderry Township Bedford County) now Alegani Towns-
hip Somerset County and Surveyed the 13th day of September
1809 in pursuance of a Land Office Receipt for a Warrant
of 250^a dated the 28th day of January 1793. Granted to Jacob
Buss which Warrant was Executed by my Predecessor on
this Ground. But a^d Warrant together with the original Draught
cannot be found being mislaid, or perhaps remains in
the Deputy Surveyors office at Bedford.
