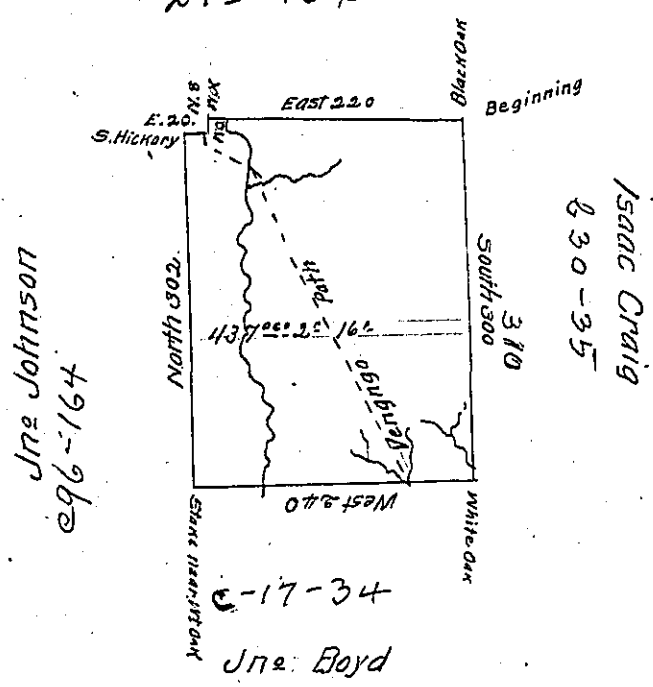

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April 4th 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Hugh Alesh for 400 Acres of Lands dated the 10th day of Feby 1794 on both sides of the Venango Path, adjoining James Johnson North and West of the River Ohio & Alleghany and Conawango Creek on the Waters of Lowries Run Called Black Oak Levels Containing four hundred and thirty seven acres and half and Sixteen poles together with the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads
