



Situate in West Township Huntingdon County Containing One hundred Seventy-two Acres 45 perches & the usual allowance. The same being part of a tract of Land first Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Andrew Armstrong dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1763 & Resurveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1816, in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property. Granted to John P. Mc Knight dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1808. The Reservey was then said to contain 205 Acres 14 perches & allowance. This part re-surveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April 1831.
