



Situate in Manshan Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 34<sup>ac</sup> & 82 perches and allowance of 6 per Cent &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 227<sup>ac</sup> & 23 perches and allowance &c. which was originally surveyed by Lewis Lewis late D.S. under Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1771. In Pursuance of the Application No 2100 for 100<sup>ac</sup> Granted to John Calhoon bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1766 Resurveyed by John Forsythe in the month of May 1799. And on the 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> days of May A.D. 1800 Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land and at the request of the owner David Branizer the same is now returned for Confirmation the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December 1814.
