That the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahela and Ohio do hereby Certify that James Brownlee is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Shirtes to include his Actual Settlement made in the Year one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy four

Given Under our hands at Cox^s fort the Seventeenth day of February 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
