



A Draught of a Survey lying on Pike Run in Washington County, call'd Maiden's Hall contg. 414 Ac.<sup>s</sup> & 20 P<sup>s</sup> without any Allowce, executed January 31<sup>st</sup> 1786. in pursuance of a Certificate for 400 Ac.<sup>s</sup> in the Name of Jos. Brenton granted him by the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> from Virg<sup>a</sup> and regularly entered with the County Surveyor as appears from the authenticated List of Entries in my Hands.
