That the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Monongahela, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby certify that Charles Bonner is Entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Buffalo to Include his Actual Settlement made in the Year one thousand Seven hundred ~~Hundred~~ and Seventy seven & also a right in preemption to one thousand acres Adjoining thereto
