Office from John Lukens Esq. Surveyor General  
for the State of Pennsylvania Bearing date at  
Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783.  
The Above tract of land Containing two Hund-  
red & six Acres, and 20 Perches, and Allowance  
of 6 P Cent for Roads &c. Was surveyed on  
the 24<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
