Surveyed the first Day of May A.D. 1838. In pursuance of a Warrant for 30^{as} granted to Daniel Brillhart, bearing date the 6th day of December A.D. 1837.

The Improvements on the above described Tract of Land at the time of Surveying Consisted of a Dwelling House Stable Barn and other out Houses with near all cleared Land rendering it an actual personal resident Settlement with a manifest intention of making it a place of a home & Means of Supporting a family Commenced prior to the 28th day of March 1814 Made about 87 Years ago
