Enclosed is a Return for Robert Brown Esq^r The Warrant for 12 Acres altho Mr. Brown intended to take all the Vacancy it is a piece of Barrens left between the adjoining Plantations I thought if I left 12 or 13^{ac} out perhaps it might not be taken at all & really concluded it would be the Interest of the State to include all the Vacancy in this Survey there being no other Warrant or Order of any kind for any part of it to the best of my knowledge and belief And I hope my conduct will meet with your Approbation
