



A Draught of Forty two acres and 10 perches and the allowance of Six Percent for roads &c Part of a larger Tract of land situate in Ferrisburgh Township formerly Cumberland - now Mifflin County, appears Surveyed the 29th day of July 1769 (By Wm MacLay late Deputy Surveyor) and said to contain 207 1/2 acres &c.
