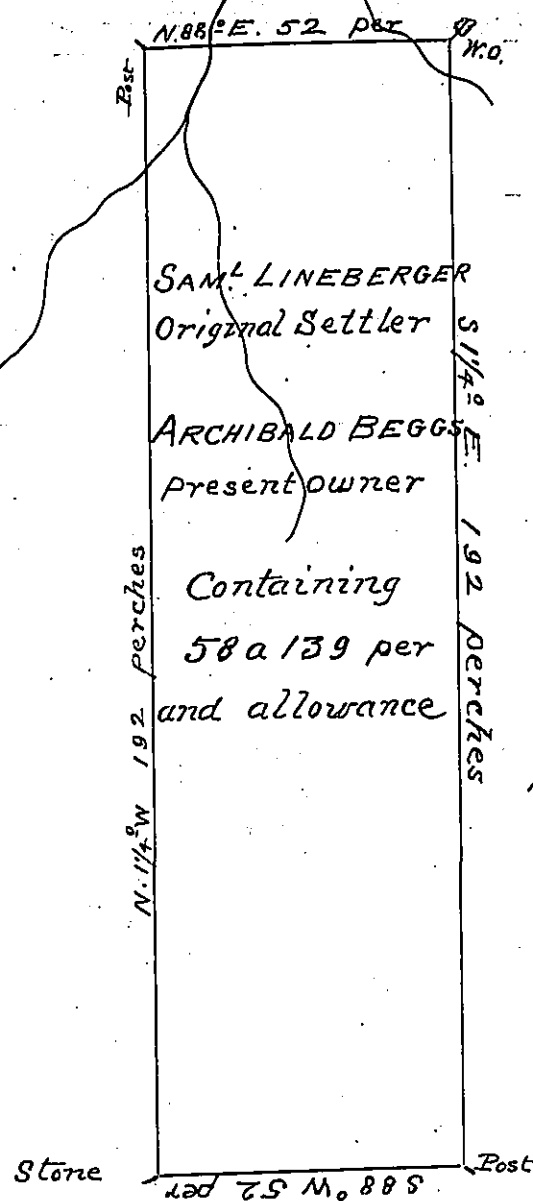

D. 1751 and I do hereby certify that from the survey books and official documents in my possession the above described land applied for tract of land does not appear to have been surveyed or appropriated to any other person than said applicant or any other person under whom he claims the same by warrant or otherwise.
