Also part of a tract which appears to have been surveyed by James Harris Nov. 14<sup>th</sup> 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Elliott for 150<sup>a</sup> dated August 29<sup>th</sup> 1793 Resurveyed by Wm Harris April 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> 1806 in pursuance of an order of the Board of property dated August 5<sup>th</sup> 1805 and a warrant dated August 29<sup>th</sup> 1793 and said to contain 163<sup>a</sup> 110<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ft & allowance of 6 percent for Roads &c. Examined Dec 13<sup>th</sup> 1851 and the above found to contain 168<sup>a</sup> 83<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ft as above shown
