



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793 and order of Survey received May 1<sup>st</sup> 1847 Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1847 to Charles Boyd the above described Tract of land situate in Lehman Township Pike County (formerly Northampton County) near land formerly granted to George Walter now William Oberfield containing four hundred and nine acres one hundred and fifty five perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. by John T. Cross Ad.
