



Draught of a Tract of Land. Surveyed January 15th 1815 by James Murry formerly Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a warrant dated December 21st 1814 granted to John Beninger on the South side of Cona-maugh river on the Waters of Tub Mill Creek in Fairfield Township Westmoreland County Containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres and One Hundred and Twenty Eight Perches and Allowance of Six Per Cent. Taken from the original draught remaining in my office the 14th day of February 1818.
