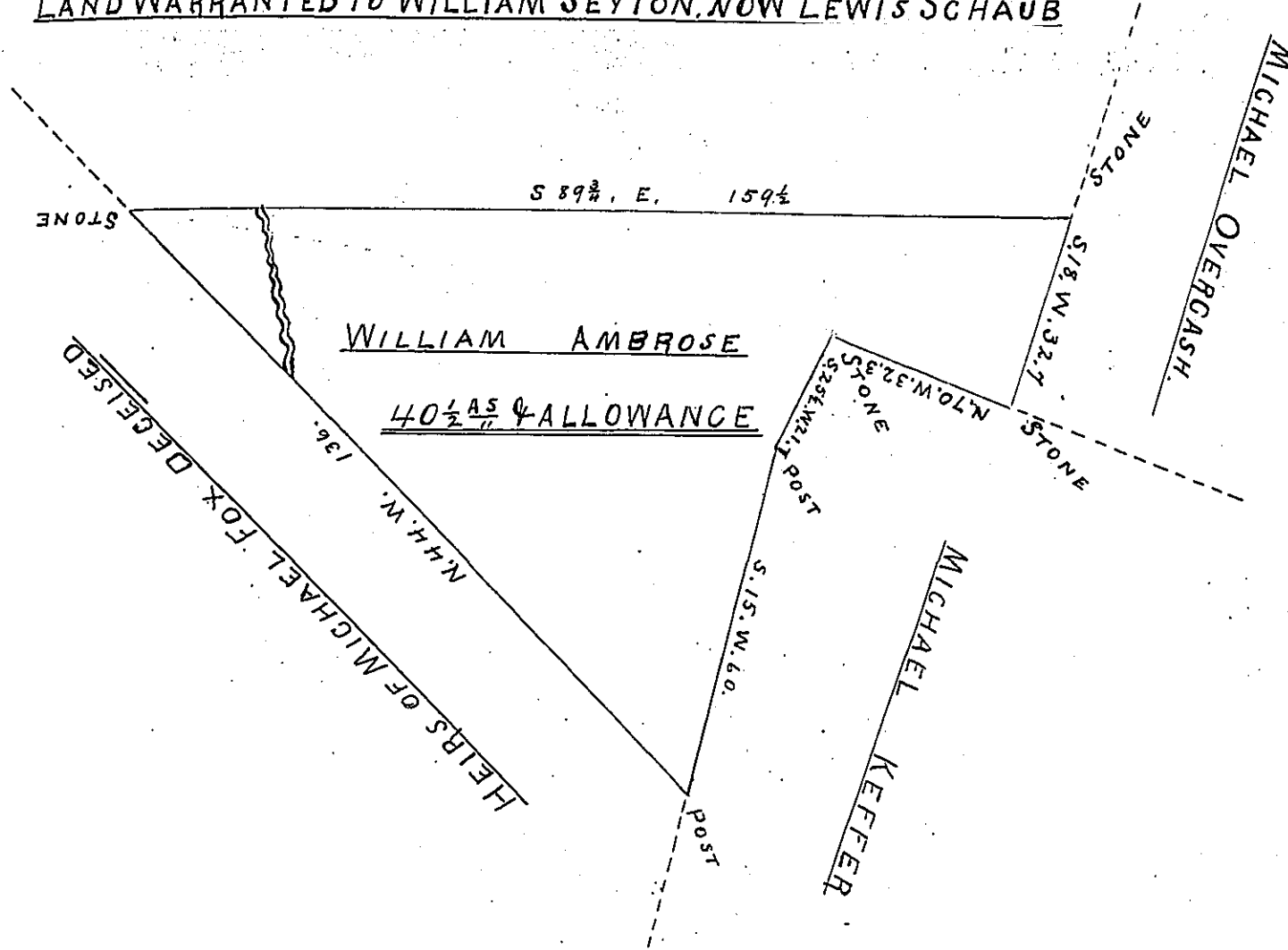


LAND WARRANTED TO WILLIAM SEYTON, NOW LEWIS SCHAUB



January 30<sup>th</sup> 1858

Surveyed the above described tract of Land in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Ambrose, bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1854. Situate on the Eastern Slope of the Chestnut Ridge in Ligonier township Westmoreland County. Containing Forty and one half acres and the Usual allowance of Six per cent &c.
