Archibald McCall of the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> Merchant enters a caveat to the granting a patent to James & Wm Blaine or either of them for the above Survey the 5th McCall claiming 200 acres of sd Land by virtue of a Contract between him & John Black whose Assignees they or one of them is & by virtue of an Improvement & Survey in the name of Joseph Irwin & of a Warrant of Acceptance therefor 155/1061 the 25th March 1795
