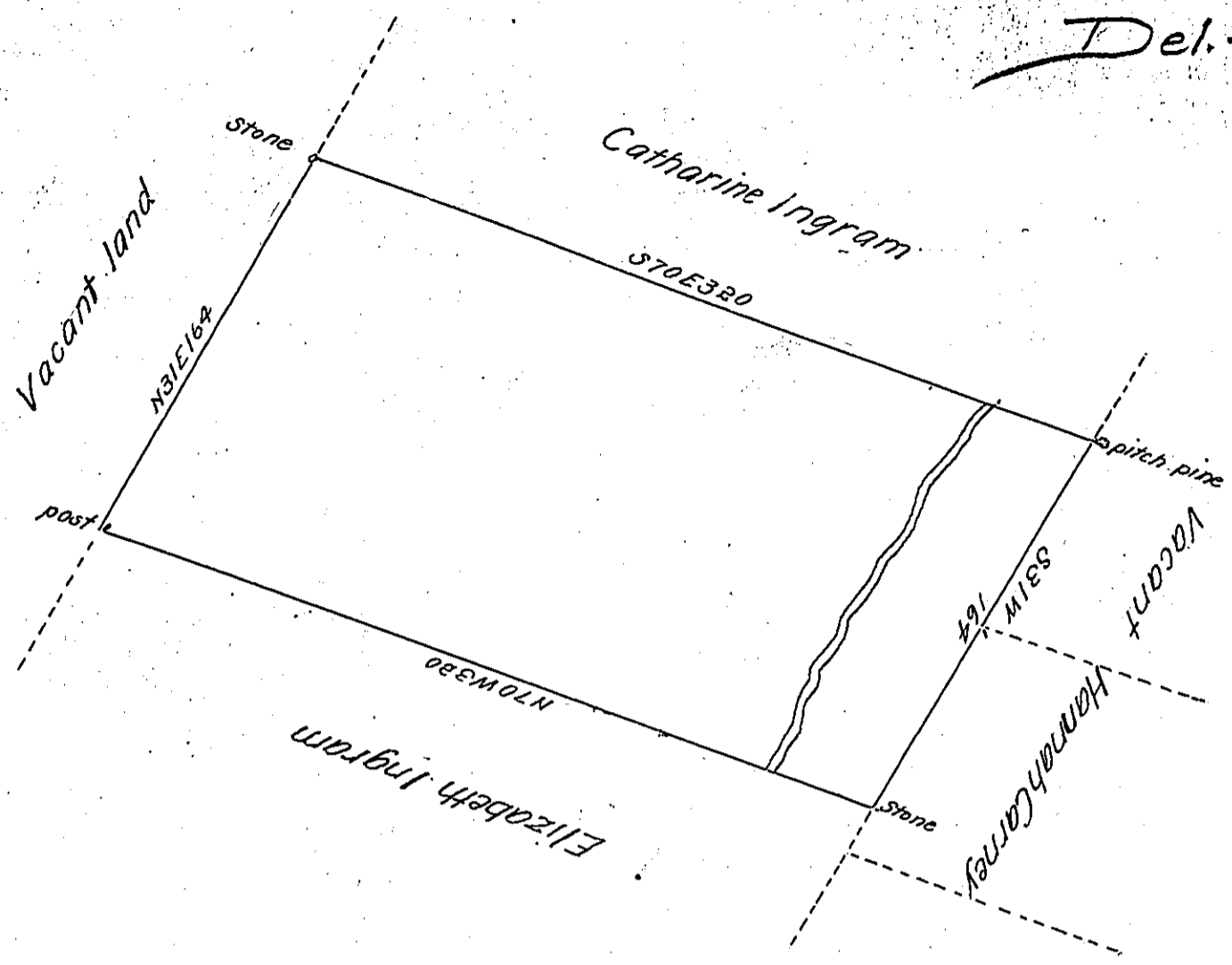


Del. - PIKE. ✓



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 17<sup>th</sup> December 1784 Surveyed  
 the 3<sup>d</sup> October 1787 to Thomas Carney the above described tract of land

 about one mile from Shoholy road & about four miles from Delaware  
 River in Northampton County Containing three hundred and three Acres  
 123 perches and the Allowance of Six P Cent &c<sup>a</sup>
