



The above is Part of a large tract of Land Situate on Layelsock Creek and on the North side of the west Branch of Susquahana River in the County of Northd the said large whole tract of land was Survey'd for Samuel Purviance on the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1769 By Virtue of his application dated the 4<sup>th</sup> Day February 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 16 & Cor<sup>(obl)</sup>lines three thousand Eight hundred and Eighty Acres of land with the Allowance of Six P Cent & the above said Part was Re-survey'd and laid off from the said whole Tract by me the 29<sup>th</sup> Day October 1795 Containing one thousand Acres & the usual allowance.
