



A draught of a tract of land containing two hundred and ninety five acres and ninety two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads including an improvement began the first day of July 1805 consisting of a framed house the residence of a family a barn an orchard and thirty or more acres of improved land Situate on Wapasing Creek in the Township of Windham and County of Bradford Surveyed the 23^d day of December 1815 to Darius Brainard in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day of October 1815
