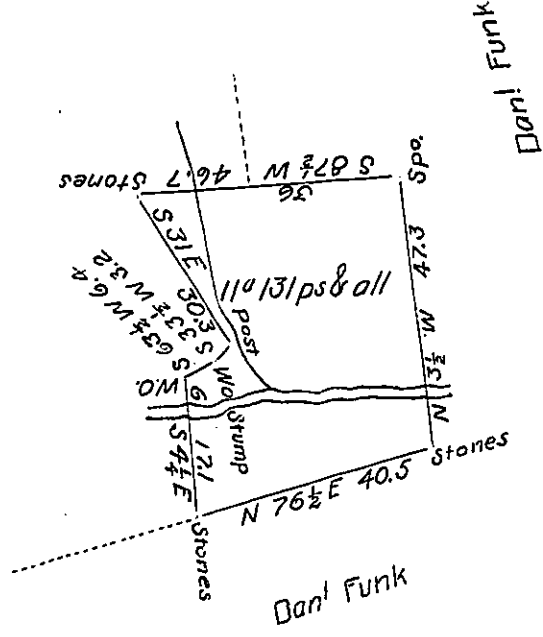


Eleazer Brandon formerly

 warrant but did not belong to the same person at that time Contain-
 ing eleven acres one hundred & thirty one perches & all.


