Anno 1744 who afterwards sold his Right to the above Tract to the said Jacob Long & the remainder to Philip Basters - divided for them on the 24th Feby Anno 1769 - And now Resurveyed on the 3d of September Anno 1781 in pursuance of a Warr! of Resurvey & by Order of the Sureweyer General dated on the 22d Aug! Anno 1781.
