



Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Longswamp in the County of Berks, containing sixty two acres, fifty five perches and the allowance of six per cent. for roads &c, surveyed for the Thomas Iron Company and Andrew Long the twenty eight day of February 1872 being part of a large tract of one hundred and eight acres and One hundred and forty six perches, and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Burger dated the fourteenth day of November 1744. Resurveyed to Jacob Long and Phillip Basters by Order of the Surveyor General date 22^d August 1781.
