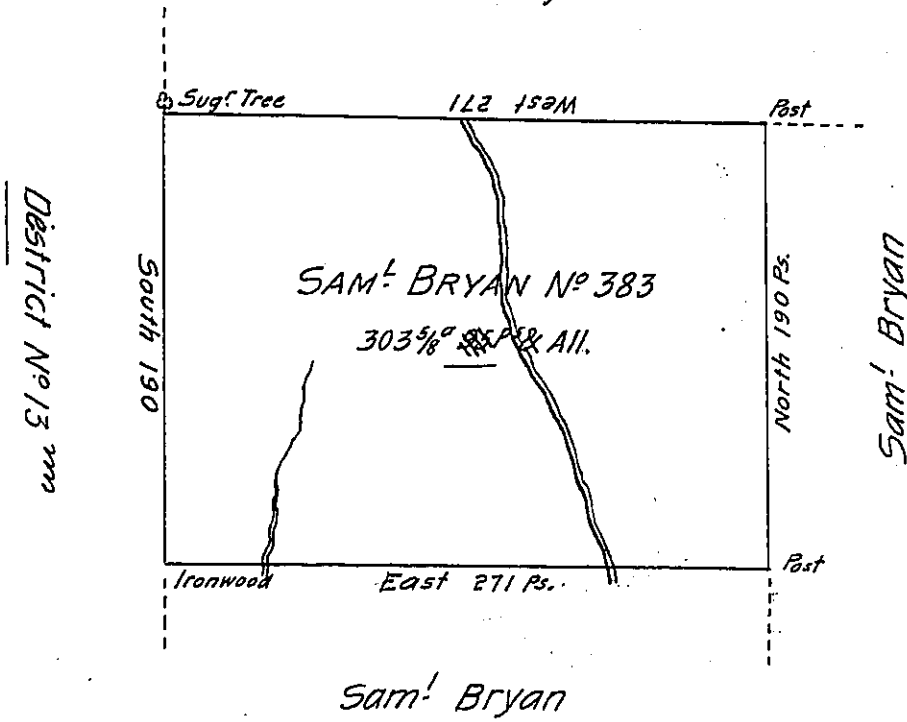


Jonathan D. Sergeant
