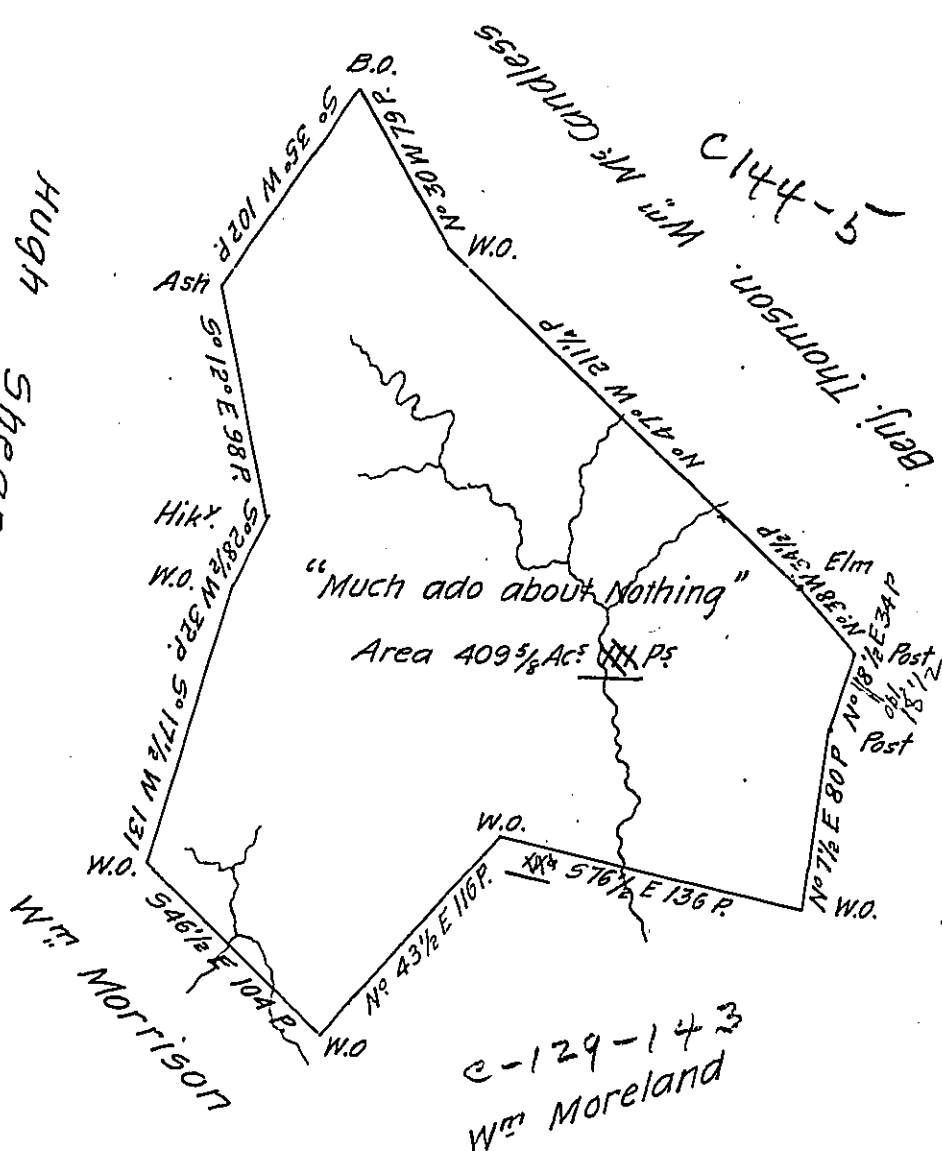

In consequence of a Certif^r for 400 Ac^s granted to Jacob Leiphart by the Commiss^{rs} appointed by Virg^a to adjust the claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monong^a Yohg^a & Ohio and duly entered with the County Surv^r as appears from the List of Entries transmitted from the Surv Gen^{ls} office Ent^d 26th Feb. 1780.
