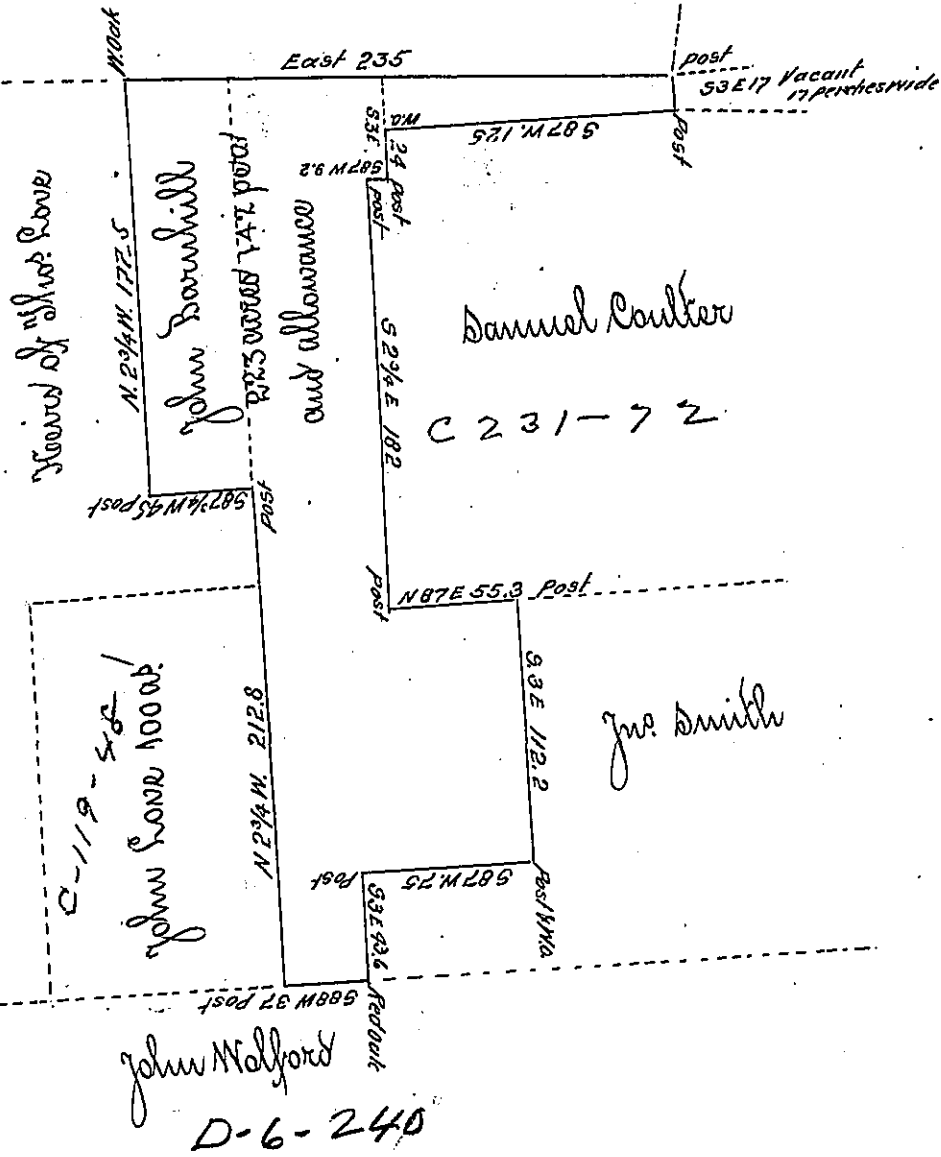

Bounded as described above containing two hundred twenty three acres 142 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c

Fifty acres of the N. West Corner of this Survey marked by a dotted line, was purchased by John Barnhill from Tho<sup>s</sup> Love in his lifetime. The original Survey of this land is not entered on the Survey Book, as I understand it the land eastward was Claimed by Joseph Powell, and Considerable Contest about it. And finally Settled, to the above form.
