



This is a draft of a tract of land situate in Delaware township in Worcester County, being the west end of an undrawn tract of donation land numbered seven hundred, and sixty seven in the general draft of the 4th district surveyed for Thos. Crosson, 16th of March 1832 in pursuance of an actual settlement and residence, commenced by Obadiah Shaver, (he says) in 1815 and sold to said Crosson surveyed according to the original corners and lines on the ground containing one hundred and three acres 21 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads and bounded as above described
