



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Peters Township Franklin (late Cumberland) County containing forty five acres and one fourth of an acre and the usual Allowance of six p. cent for Roads &c. Surveyed February 16<sup>th</sup> 1776 in pursuance of a Warrant granted Andrew Biggart dated the 17<sup>th</sup> of December 1774, by an Assistant of John Armstrong (formerly a Deputy Surveyor) as appears by <sup>an</sup> official draught thereof remaining on file in the Deputy Surveyors Office of Franklin County
