



The above described tract of one hundred and fifty two acres & one hundred and seven-  
 teen perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is part of a larger tract of 220 Acres  
 57 perches & allowance, situate now in Heston (formerly Stannet) Township Franklin Cam-  
 bly, which was surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> of April 1793 (by Heatt<sup>o</sup> Henderson Esq. then Deputy Sur-  
 veyor) in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Bryan bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of  
 December 1792. Resurveyed & divided off the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1824
