



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Locust Bend situate (obl.) south side of the West Branch of Susquehanna River about one Mile (obl.) below land of William Patterson Esquire and about half a Mile above Land of Dr. William Smith and supposed to be ten Miles above Chinglelamouche Old Town in the County of Bedford. Containing three hundred and sixty five Acres and the usual Allowance of six p. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the first Day of July 1773 for Charles Cist in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to (obl.) Dated the 12th Day of May in the same year by
