



Whereas David Christie on the 20th Apl 1787 obtained a Survey containing three hundred and Eighty five Acres and Allowance in pursuance of his Warrant dated July 20th 1784. Situate in Armstrong Township in the County of Westm^g. and Whereas Jacob Hess purchased a part of the same Tract and requested James Ross late Deputy Surv^r or some person under him to Survey and lay off his part of Said Tract and as it appears by the Draught now in my office that one hundred and fifty four Acres and 20 perches ~~one eight~~ had been Surveyed to the said Jacob Hess on the 21st Sept^r 1798 Which I have examined and find tolerable correct.
