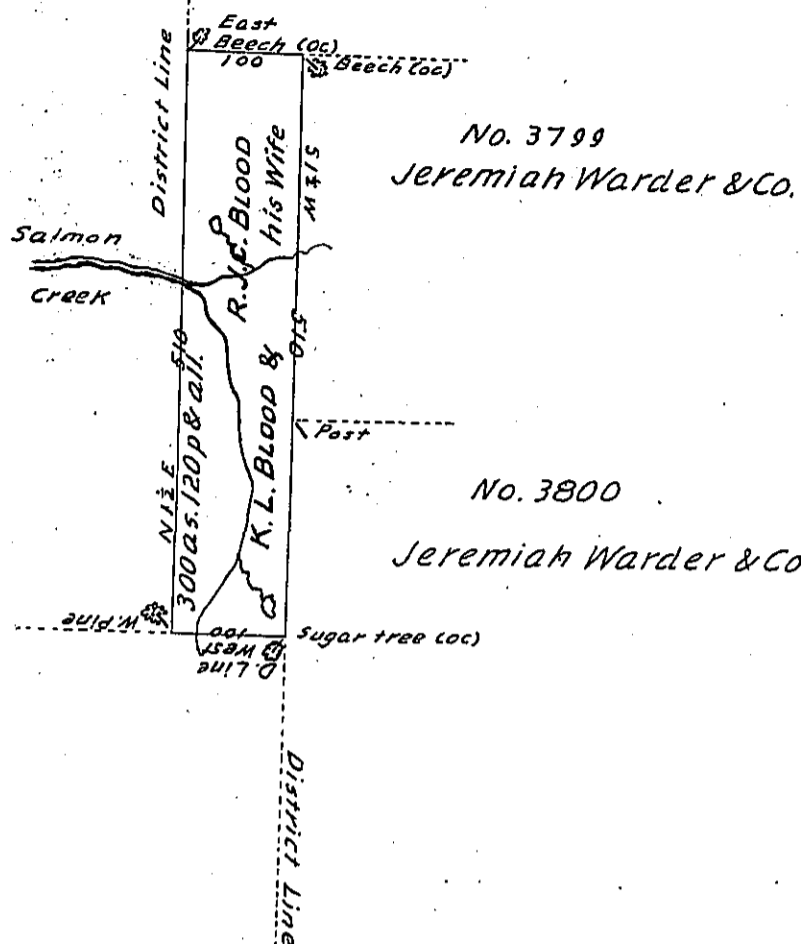

By Virtue of a Warrant, granted to Kennedy L. Blood and Rebecca Jane Blood his wife, of the Borough of Brookville. Dated the ninth day of December A.D. 1858, and to me directed: I have, this 22nd day of December A.D. 1858. Located said Warrant in Wm. P. Brady's District, No. 5, as above.
