of November 1771 I did Resurvey on the 26th day of
December following unto Isaac Cox the above
Described Lot of ground situate on & before the
Bank between Walnut Street and the Dock in the
City of Philad^a Bounded on the North by ground
formerly Jonathan Dickinson Commonly Called
the Burnt Houses, Eastward by the River Delaware
at the extent of Two hundred & fifty feet from the East
side of Front Street Southward by ground formerly John
Wheeler Now Joseph & James Bringhurst & Westward
by Front Street Containing in breadth thirty feet & in
Length 250 feet as aforesaid there being a thirty feet
Cartway across the same forty feet from Front Street
