Bounded Northward by Vacant Ground, Eastward by Delaware Front Street Continued Southward by Callowhill Street & Westward by Ground of Benjamin Mifflin. Surveyed into Abraham Carpenter by Order and Direction of the Honourable the Proprietaries.
