



Draught of an Island situate in the River Susquehanna in Little Britain Township - Lancaster County; lying near the Middle of the River, a short distance above the Peach Bottom Falls, opposite land of John Kirk on the York County side, and land of Nicholas Boyd on the Lancaster Shore - Containing thirty eight perches, Strict Measure - Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Stephen Boyd Joseph S. Boyd & Samuel R. Boyd, Dated the 9th Day of May A.D. 1821 -
