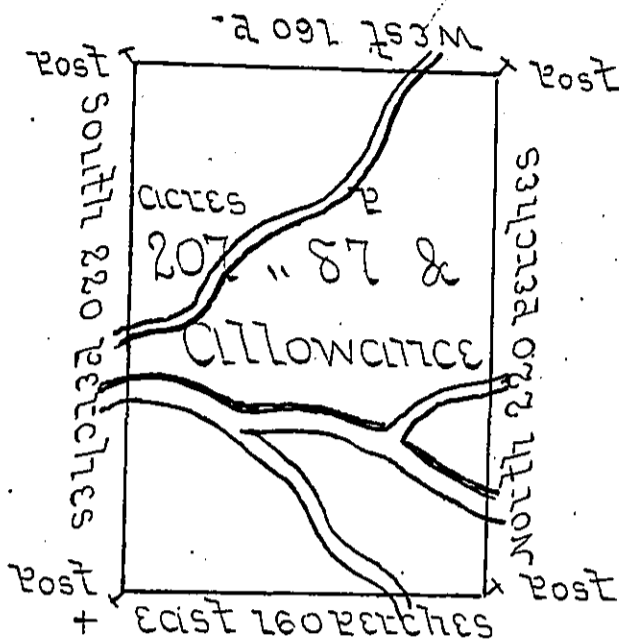

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor General for the State of Pobl. obliterated directed bearing date at Philada the 14th day of August 1786. The above Tract of land containing two hundred and seven acres & eighty seven perches with Allowance of six p^{er} Cent for Roads &c^a was Surveyed on the 1st day of July 1785 by-
