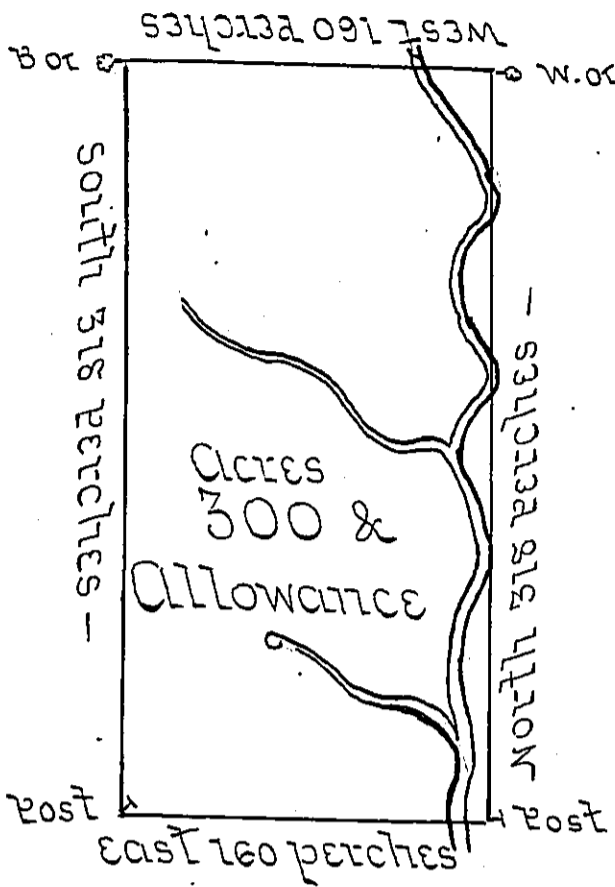

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein Mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania - to me Directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 The above tract of land containing Three hundred acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 by -
