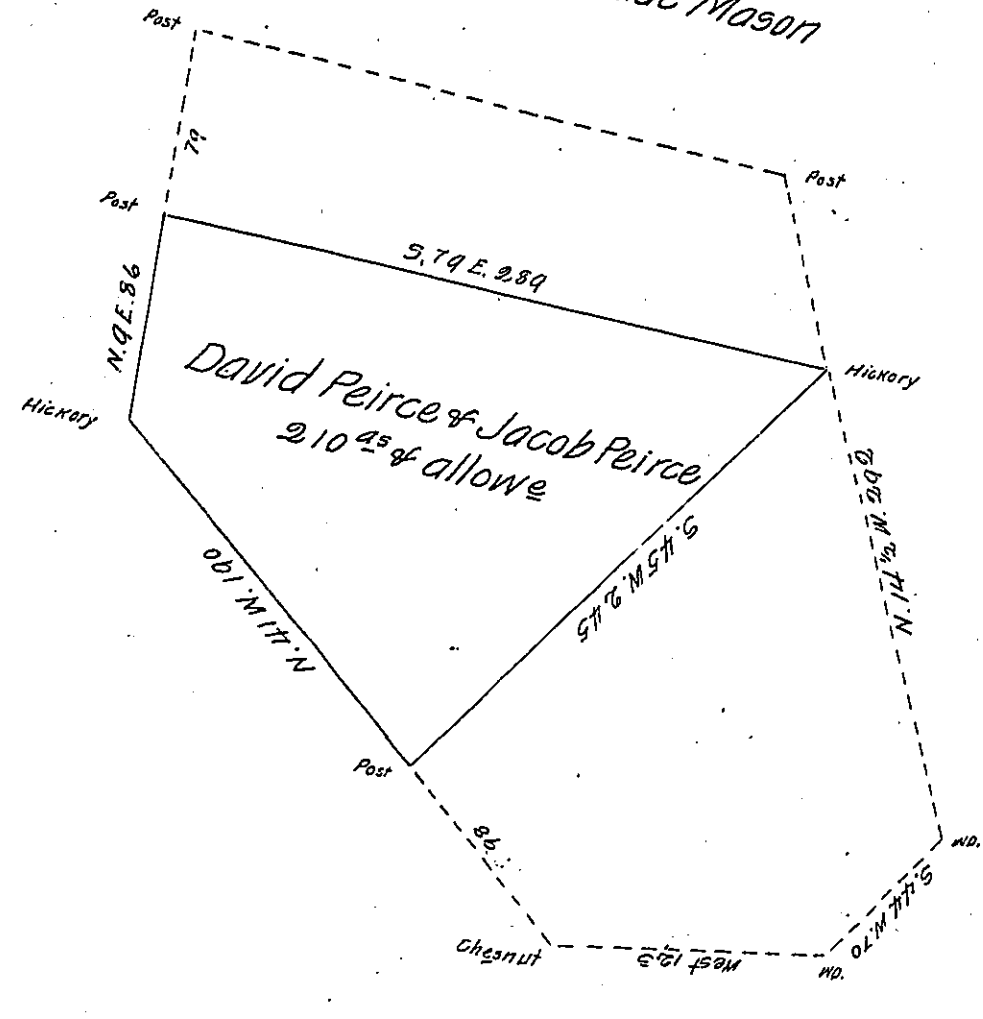


Charles Biddle & Isaac Mason
