



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in the Long Swamp Township in the County of Burkes, and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Sixty Two Acres and 110 Perches of Land, together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent for Roads

Being the greatest Part of a Tract of 120 Acres and Allowance That was formerly Surveyed for Samuel Burgher By Warrant of the 29<sup>th</sup> December Anno 1753 The said Samuel Burgher Sold and Conveyed 57<sup>1/2</sup> 50 per and pr allowance as his Right thereto unto his Brother Philip Burgher and kept the above for himself, for whom it was now resurveyed and divided on the 6<sup>th</sup> April Anno 1769 p David Schultz
