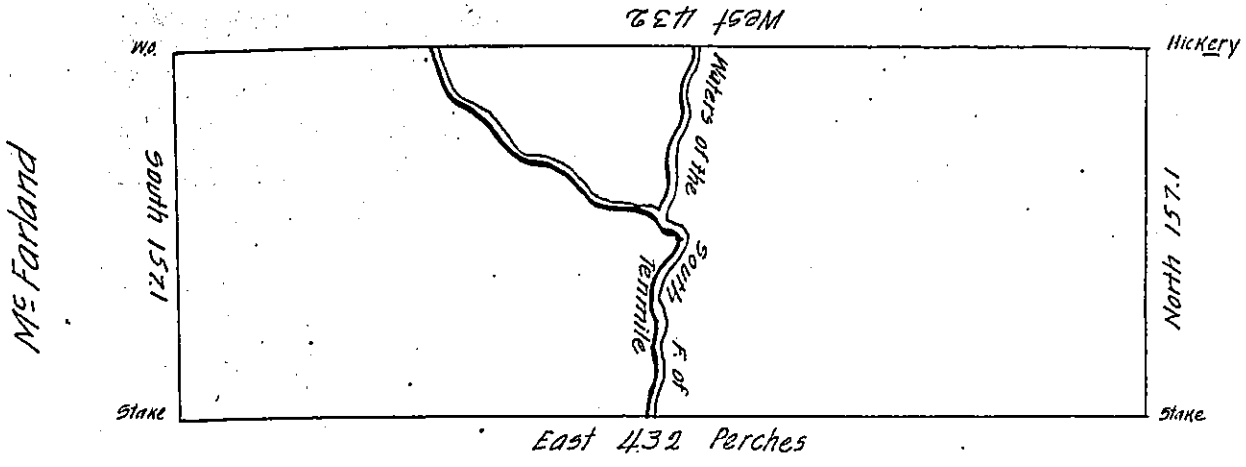


Joseph Bidal

The land is situate on the waters of the South fork of Tennile creek in Washington County and contains Four hundred Acres with Six p. Cent allowance for Roads &c.
