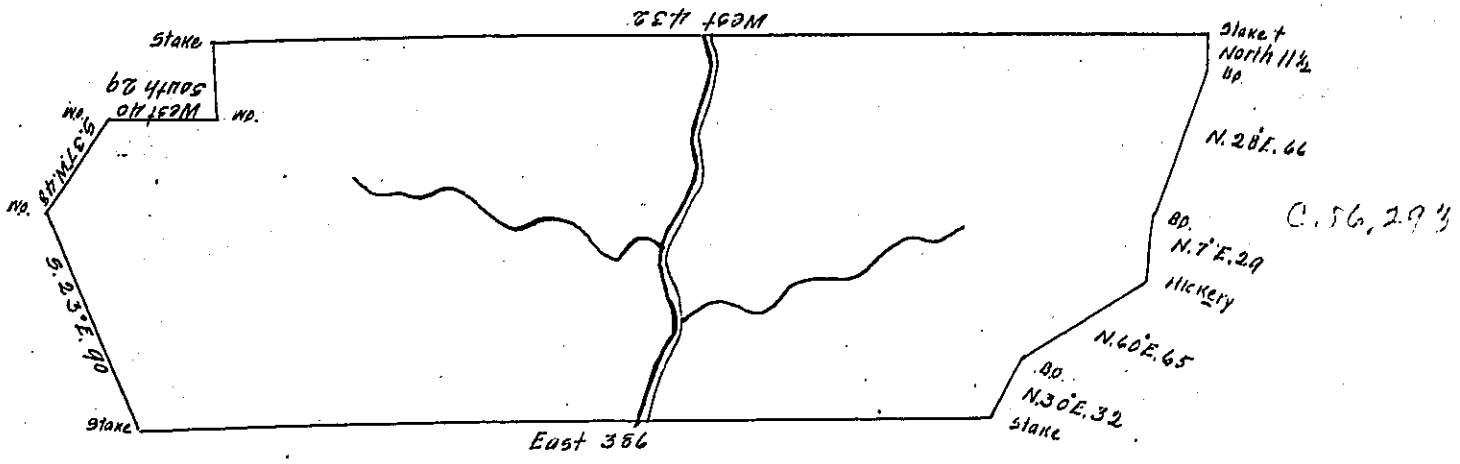


Thomas Cornwall

The land is Situate on the waters of the South fork of Ten Mile creek in the County of Washington and contains four hundred Acres with Six p Cent allowance for Roads &c.
