



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup> of April 1776 and surveyed the 17 June 1776 to John Cox the above described tract of Land Situate on a branch of Lechawaxsin Creek in Northampton C<sup>o</sup>l containing Three Hundred & thirty five Acres 122 perches & the Allowance of Six p. Cent &c<sup>a</sup> p Geo. Palmer

NB The Land adjoining y<sup>e</sup> West side of Anthony Seyfert being in dispute with Robert Wilson was given up & in consequence thereof the Governor permitted the Warrant to be surveyed here.
