Survey'd August 30<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a Virginia Certificate granted to Jacob Clyne Called Segoria Containing 379 Acres (Copy of Certificate) in Washington County

We the Commissioners appointed for Adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahala, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Jacob Clyne is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in Monongahala on the Waters of Muddy Creek to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five. Given under our hands at Redstone old fort the Eleventh day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
