

Situate in Dublin Township Huntingdon County  
Containing one hundred and fifty two acres and ninety six  
perches and Allowance Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November  
1810 for Michael Traxelor and <sup>Robert</sup> Thompson and di-  
vided between them agreeable to the above Drafts.

Note this Land was first surveyed on a warrant granted to James Berry and William Adams bearing date the fourth day of December 1787 it then contained 2.88 Acres 133 perches and Allowance and on the petition of James Berry the Board of Property at a meeting held the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1803 did order a resurvey to be made on said Land agreeable to which order it is now Surveyed and Returned Containing 303  $\frac{1}{2}$  18<sup>ds</sup> & All ce.
