taining Sixteen Acres & 6 perches & Allowance of Six per cent.

 April 24. 1840

* This return is no doubt out of place as it respects the date of the warrant but I am not to blame in this matter. The warrant was directed to Wm McCallister D.C. before my coming into Office Besides the man to whom the warrant was granted gave me no notice of it until the 10th of March 1840.
