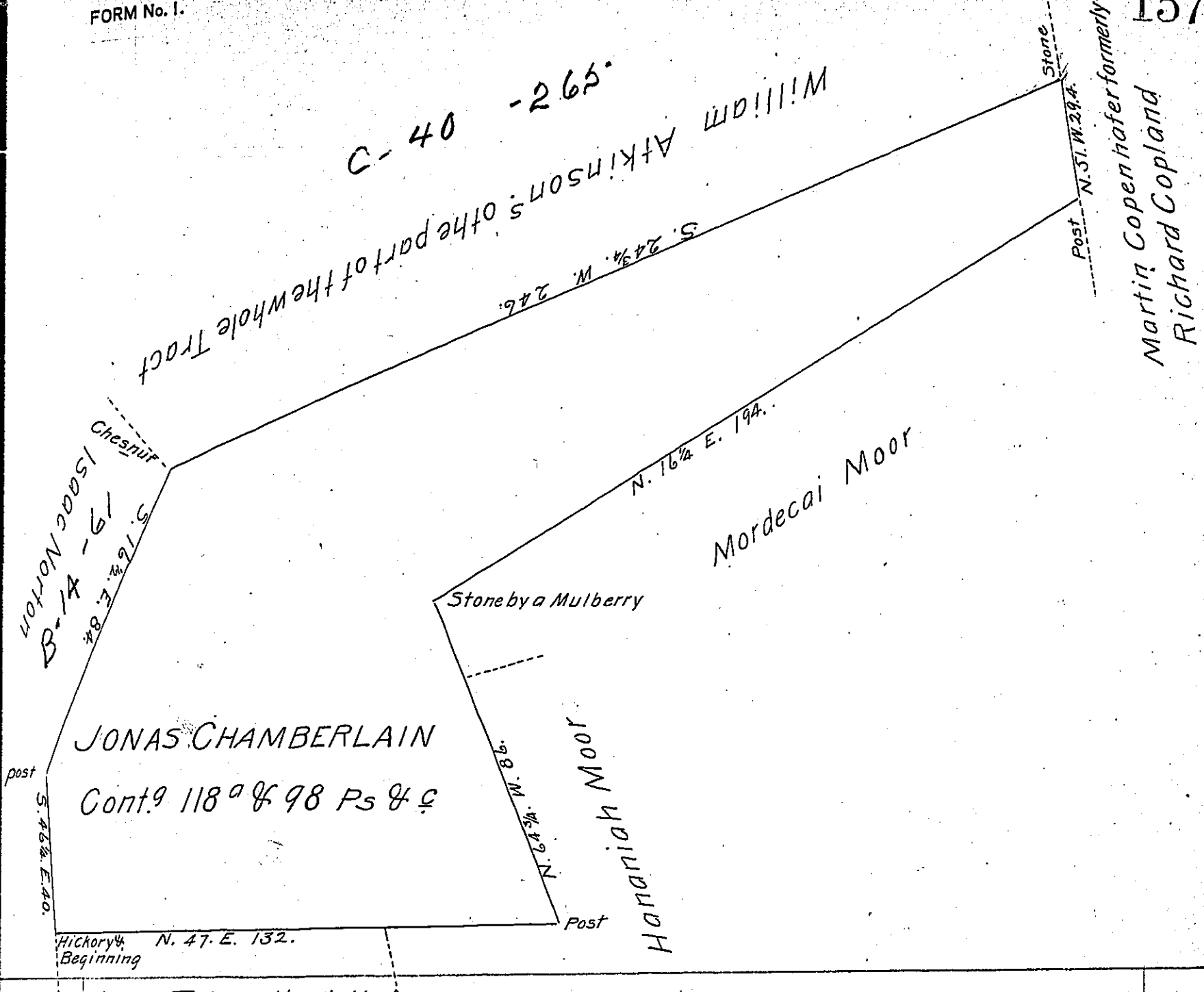

Situate in Fairview (later Newbury Township) in the County of York containing as above set forth 118<sup>a</sup> & 98<sup>p</sup> Perches & allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 300<sup>a</sup> & c of Land which was Originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D. S. on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1752. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonas Chamberlain dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December A. D. 1751 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of January A. D. 1811 at the request of the owner Solomon Tates, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
