In pursuance of a warrant, to John Campbell Bearing date the twenty six<sup>th</sup> day of February 1800 Surveyd on the twenty eight<sup>th</sup> day of November 1811 unto the aforesaid John Campbell the above discribed tract of Land Containing one hundred and Fifty nine acres and one hundred and fiftynine and one half perches and allowance proportioned at six Per Cent situate on the waters of the four Mile Run in Dunagall township in the County of Westmoreland Including his improvement thereon Consisting of a dwelling house and Barn and about Fifty acres of land Cleared and fenced, &c. First commenced to be improven in the beginning of February 1800.
