



The Draught of a Tract of land called — Situate in Penns township in the County of Union (formerly Northumberland) containing One hundred & twelve Acres and One hundred & twenty perches & the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 15th day of May Anno Dom 1813, for Jacob Gemberling, Being part of a certain Tract of land containing Three hundred and thirty two Acres and Sixty two perches, which was Surveyed the 7th day of September Domini 1767 In pursuance of an Order of Survey to the Reverd Alexander Murray bearing date At Philadelphia the 6th day of August Anno Dom 1766 and Numbered 789.
